## Management's Responsibility

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To the Members and Chief and Council of Ochiichagwe'Babigo'Ining Ojibway Nation:

Management is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the accompanying Schedule of Remuneration and Expenses – (Chiefs and Councillors) (the “Schedule”), including responsibility for significant accounting judgments and estimates in accordance with Section 7.3 of the Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada Year-End Reporting Handbook and to comply with the First Nations Financial Transparency Act. This responsibility includes selecting appropriate accounting principles and methods, and making decisions affecting the measurement of transactions in which objective judgment is required.

In discharging its responsibilities for the integrity and fairness of the Schedule, management designs and maintains the necessary accounting systems and related internal controls to provide reasonable assurance that transactions are authorized, assets are safeguarded and financial records are properly maintained to provide reliable information for the preparation of financial information.

Chief and Council is responsible for overseeing management in the performance of its financial reporting responsibilities, and for approving the financial information included in the Schedule. The Council fulfils these responsibilities by reviewing the financial information prepared by management and discussing relevant matters with management and external accountants. The Council is also responsible for recommending the appointment of the First Nation's external accountants.

MNP LLP is appointed by Chief and Council to review the Schedule and report directly to them; their report follows. The external accountants have full and free access to, and meet periodically and separately with, both the Council and management to discuss their review engagement results.

To the Members and Chief and Council of Ochiichagwe'Babigo'Ining Ojibway Nation:

We have reviewed the Schedule of Remuneration and Expenses – (Chiefs and Councillors) of Ochiichagwe'Babigo'Ining for the year ended March 31, 2016. The Schedule has been prepared by management based on the requirement of the First Nations Financial Transparency Act. Our review was made in accordance with Canadian generally accepted standards for review engagements and, accordingly, consisted primarily of inquiry, analytical procedures and discussion related to information supplied to us by the First Nation.

A review does not constitute an audit and, consequently, we do not express an audit opinion on the Schedule of Remuneration and Expenses – (Chiefs and Councillors).

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe the Schedule of Remuneration and Expenses – (Chiefs and Councillors) is not, in all material respects, in accordance with the First Nations Financial Transparency Act.

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**1. Significant accounting policies**

The Schedule has been prepared in accordance with Section 7.3 of the Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada Year-End Reporting Handbook and to comply with the First Nations Financial Transparency Act using the following significant accounting policy:

***Basis of accounting***

The basis of accounting used in the preparation of the Schedule does not materially differ from Canadian public sector accounting standards.

**2. First Nations Financial Transparency Act**

The First Nation is required by the First Nations Transparency Act to post its consolidated financial statements on a website and submit consolidated financial statements to INAC by July 29, 2016. As the report date is after this date, the First Nation is not in compliance with the requirement. The possible effect of this non-compliance has not yet been determined.
