


REVIEW ENGAGEMENT REPORT

To the Members of Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation

At the request of Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation, we have reviewed the Schedule of Federal Government Funding for the Band for the year ended March 31, 2005, calculated pursuant to the requirements of the Department of Indian Affairs Year-end Reporting Handbook dated November, 2003. Our review was made in accordance with Canadian generally accepted standards for review engagements and accordingly consisted primarily of enquiry, analytical procedures and discussion related to information supplied to us by the Band.

A review does not constitute an audit and consequently we do not express an audit opinion on this Schedule of Federal Government Funding.

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that this Schedule of Federal Government Funding is not, in all material respects, in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Indian Affairs Year-end Reporting Handbook dated November, 2003.
