## Review Engagement Report

### To the Members Brunswick House First Nation

At the request of the Brunswick House First Nation, we have reviewed the Schedule of Federal Government Funding for the year ended March 31, 2005, calculated pursuant to the requirements of the Department of Indian Affairs Year-end Reporting Handbook dated November, 2003. Our review was made in accordance with Canadian generally accepted standards for review engagements and accordingly consisted primarily of enquiry, analytical procedures and discussion related to information supplied to us by the First Nation, except as explained below.

A review does not constitute an audit and consequently we do not express an audit opinion on this Schedule of Salaries, Honoraria, Travel Expenses and Other Remuneration.

The First Nation was not able to provide satisfactory evidence with respect to its expenditures. Accordingly, we were not able to satisfy ourselves that all expenditures of the First Nation have been properly recorded. As a result, we were unable to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to the total expenditures from all sources.

Because of our inability to complete a review, as described in the preceding paragraph, we are unable to express any assurance as to whether the Schedule of Federal Government Funding is, in all material respects, in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Indian Affairs Year-end Reporting Handbook dated November, 2003.
